

Castle Conquest

Learning Target: Multiplication Facts

Materials:

- 2 players
- Castle Conquest game board
- 2 pencils/markers (different colors)
- 2 dice or number cubes

Directions:

1. The first player rolls the dice and multiplies the 2 numbers. He/she then claims that amount of squares on the game board with his/her colored marker. The player may choose any available squares, however they have to make the array of the 2 numbers he/she multiplied. For example, if a player rolled a 5 and 6, he/she would need to find an area of 5 x 6 squares to claim.
2. The player then records his acquired area as " $5 \times 6 = 30$ ".
3. The second player then takes a turn and records his/her acquired area.
4. Players continue taking turns until the entire game board is covered or until neither player can claim any area for six successive turns.
5. The object of the game is to claim the most area on the game board.
