

## HOW TO PLAY COLLECTING DOLLARS

### Materials

- One deck of Coin Cards

Players: 2 or 3

### How to Play

1. Deal out 8 Coin Cards face up. Put the rest of the pack in a pile face down.
2. Take turns finding pairs of cards that equal one dollar.
3. If everyone agrees that no combinations of the 8 cards make one dollar, shuffle all 8 back in the pack and deal 8 new cards.
4. At the end of your turn, draw new cards from the pack to replace the cards that you used. The next player should have 8 cards to choose from.
5. The goal is to collect as many pairs of cards (dollars) as possible.
6. The game ends when all the cards have been paired.

### Scoring Variation

Make combinations of cards that equal any whole number of dollars. For example, a player could take three cards with 50¢, 70¢, and 80¢ for a total of \$2.00. You may decide to score by number of dollars collected or by number of cards collected.
